I think we should offer -v and -vv flags instead, where -v prints to stdout what currently goes to admin.log, and -vv prints what currently goes to server\_calls.log.

That's a good question. I personally feel like it's a little fuzzy since

it does actually cause multi-process issues. Also, it is doubtful (though not impossible) that people are actually doing integration that depends on these log files existing.

Due to the fact that doing it the way we are doing it breaks multi-process, and due to it being unlikely that anyone depends on this behavior, I would vote that it is OK to change with a 2.Y.

However, if others feel strongly, I would be cool with waiting for the 3.0 release too.
