Description

Hi,

I was attempting to sync an image on a private docker distribution registry with pulp.

I was getting "Could not find registry API at <https://url:port>" even though i was able to successfully pull images from the exact same url. With the help of mhrivnak, I was able to trace the error to an SSL certificate issue ie pulp did not recognize the self signed ssl certificate of the registry which was setup on the pulp-admin client sitting on a different node.

With the error message itself, it is difficult to pinpoint the fact that the error was due to the certificate problem.
