The RHSM product-id (YUM) plugin completely re-configures the root logger. As a result, goferd stops logging to syslog after the pulp (gofer) plugin performs a yum operation. A bug has been filed against RHSM https://bugzilla.redhat.com/show_bug.cgi?id=1334916 .

The RHSM YUM plugins reconfigure the root logger. As a result, goferd stops logging to syslog immediately after the RPM handler uses YUM. The workaround for this would be to have the Yum class in rpmttools capture the state of root logger configuration on construction and restore it in close(). Bugs have been filed against RHSM. If they are fixed, we can do nothing in Pulp.
