As Issue #2096 identifies, each incremental publish leaves a copy of updateinfo.xml.gz in the repodata folder. The repomd.xml file sometimes links to the wrong updateinfo.xml.gz file. If that incremental publish brings in additional errata then those errata will not be published.
