<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Pulp 3 is not expected to support EL6, where SCL is available for Python 3.4 only</li><li>• There is Python 3.5 SCL for EL7 available.</li><li>• <a href="#">Next Django release (2.0) will support Python 3.5+</a></li><li>• No impact on Django version choice, both Django LTS versions, 1.8 and 1.11, support Python 3.5</li><li>• <a href="#">Next major Celery release will support only Python 3.5</a></li></ul>
