Description The docker plugin currently requires the user to create a Publication before the content of the RepositoryVersion can be made available via a Distribution. There is no publisher that would generate metadata for the content, so the Publication and RepositoryVersion are exactly the same. The creation of a Publication is unnecessary steps. The user should be able to create a Distribution with a reference to a RepositoryVersion.
