<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Create repository2) Create a repository version with some content3) Create a publication4) Create a content guard5) Create distribution that is associated with the publication and the content guard.6) Create another repository7) Create a remote that has a URL pointing at the Distribution from step 5 and uses the client certificate for the content guard8) Create a repository version for the second repository by syncing from the remote9) Assert that the sync is successful10) Update the remote with a different client certificate11) Sync from the remote again12) Assert a failure occurs.
