**Description**

Orphan clean up needs to find all content that is not in any repository version. The current query<sup>0</sup> considers content NOT orphaned if it has ever been in any repository version. The query needs to take into consideration the 'version\_added' and 'version\_removed' fields<sup>1</sup>.
