Description

Background

The [CONTENT_ORIGIN setting](#) is a required Pulp setting, and if unset Pulp refuses to start. This is by design.

In that situation the user receives a message that says You must specify the CONTENT_ORIGIN setting. This comes from this line in the settings file: <https://github.com/pulp/pulpcore/blob/master/pulpcore/app/settings.py#L233>

This error message is technically correct, but it's not very helpful.

Solution

1. Switch the exception type to be a Django [ImproperlyConfigured](#) exception.
2. Make the text longer. It should include:
 - That the CONTENT_ORIGIN setting is required.
 - That the Installer sets it automatically
 - It could be a permissions problem.
