The installer sub-team agreed that we will port these tests (meant for molecule and written in ruby inspec) to ansible tasks: <a href="https://github.com/pulp/pulp_installer/blob/master/molecule/scenario_resources/tests/test_default.rb">https://github.com/pulp/pulp_installer/blob/master/molecule/scenario_resources/tests/test_default.rb</a>			
Presumably, there will be a new verification role at the end of the installer.			
Upon further investigation:			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The ansible URI and assert modules should probably be used.</li><li>2. Counting the redirects may not be possible with the ansible URI module.</li><li>3. This should be run on the webserver node, and querying against it.</li><li>4. Some tests like checking the services won't make since on the webserver node, since services pulpcore-api wouldn't run on a separate webserver.</li><li>5. We're going to need to add variables, at least for a complete and thorough check (beyond what the current ruby ones do.) The checking role will need to be aware of how many workers there are for example.</li></ol>
