When performing a sync, if repomd.xml does not exist, or primary.xml does not exist the user will simply see: Not Found This is a very helpful message, as it would be more useful to know exactly which file pulp was attempting to access. Something like: repomd.xml Not Found or repomd.xml Forbidden would be more useful.
